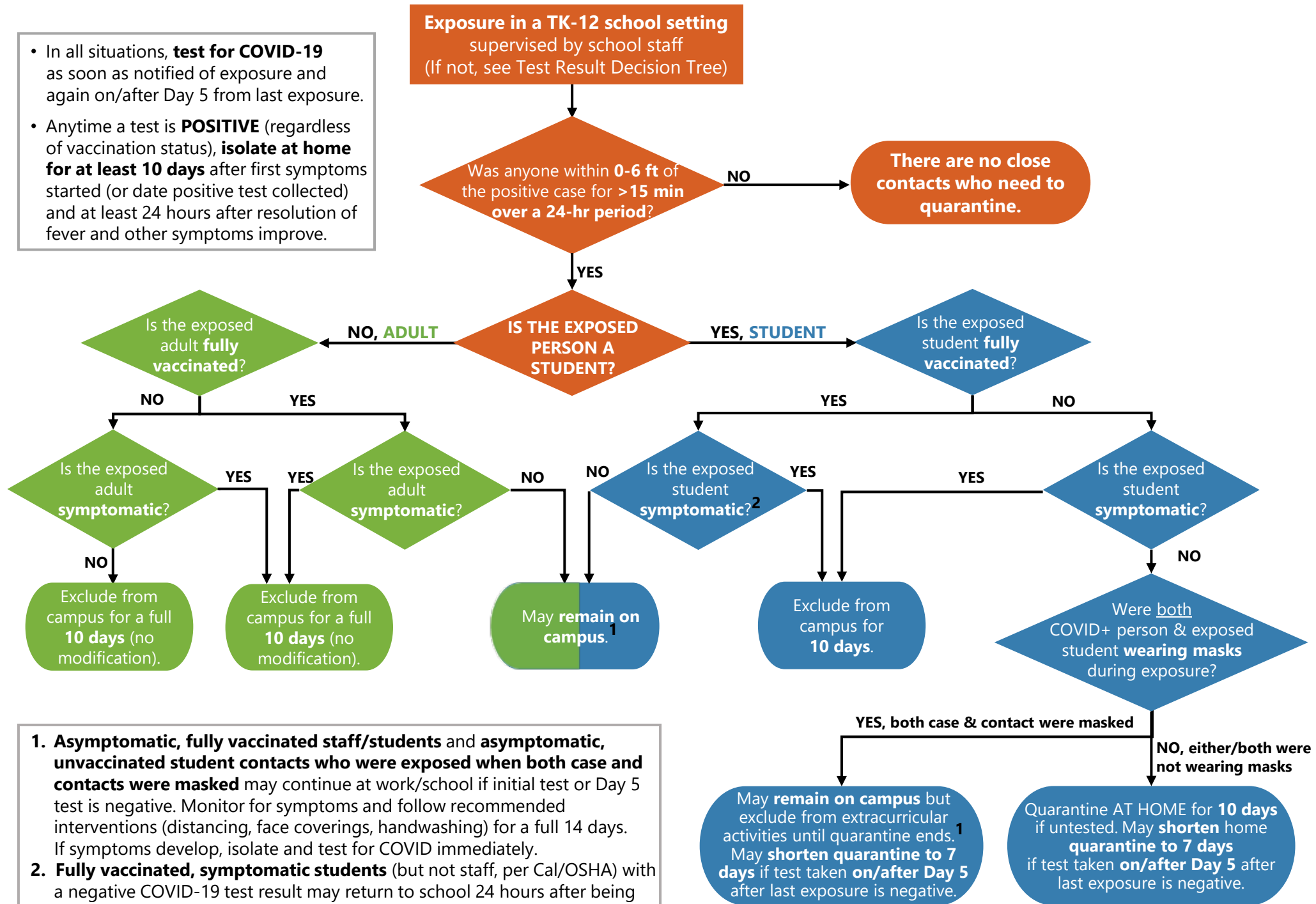


2021-2022 Quarantine Decision Tree for TK-12 School-Based Exposures

- In all situations, **test for COVID-19** as soon as notified of exposure and again on/after Day 5 from last exposure.
- Anytime a test is **POSITIVE** (regardless of vaccination status), **isolate at home for at least 10 days** after first symptoms started (or date positive test collected) and at least 24 hours after resolution of fever and other symptoms improve.



- 1. Asymptomatic, fully vaccinated staff/students and asymptomatic, unvaccinated student contacts who were exposed when both case and contacts were masked** may continue at work/school if initial test or Day 5 test is negative. Monitor for symptoms and follow recommended interventions (distancing, face coverings, handwashing) for a full 14 days. If symptoms develop, isolate and test for COVID immediately.
- 2. Fully vaccinated, symptomatic students** (but not staff, per Cal/OSHA) with a negative COVID-19 test result may return to school 24 hours after being fever-free and symptoms improve.
